I am very excited to see all of this finally start to come together after all this time. This new storage space will give us a lot of room to grow and continue our council's mission for some time to come.

Don't Forget to Vote on Election Day, November 8!

All Brother Knights and family members who are eligible to vote are encouraged to vote either on Election Day, November 8, or via Absentee Ballot. This year's general election in the Commonwealth of Virginia includes statewide races for Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General. All Virginia House of Delegate races will also take place this year as well as a vote on a school bonds referendum.

The polls open at 6:00 a.m. and will remain open until 8:00 p.m. The deadline to register to vote in this year's election is Tuesday, October 11 at 5:00 p.m. For more information on either voter registration or absentee voting, please contact the Fairfax County Office of the General Registrar at (703) 222-0076.
